



DANIEL BOONE DISTANCE RIDER ~ TEAM COMPETITIONS 2010

Rules of the game!

This year: Any ride counts. As long as three team members finishes the ride on the *same day*. Any distance counts on the same day, same ride. (All team members are not required to ride the same distance)

Ride Managers, automatically receive completion points when at least two members of their team are riding the ride. Longest distance ridden by a team member is counted for the Ride Manager. (Work requirements same as for 300 mile award)

A team roster is comprised of 3 minimum to the maximum of 8 paid DBDR members. A team of over four must include a Jr. or new rider or new DBDR member.

Bonus Rider: Extra credit points for (Jr. member, (as required by AERC), 1st year rider (never completed a sanctioned ride), new DBDR team member, (2010) A **Bonus Rider** may be one of the top three finishers of a team **or** an extra rider. (Example: Three team members finish the ride; a fourth rider (**Bonus Rider**) also gets mileage points for the team. Or if the third rider is a bonus rider as described above, he/she also gets the extra mileage points.) **Bonus Rider** mileage **always** counts.

Only one bonus rider per ride/day to count.

Bonus Riders receive half again as many mileage points ridden.

Example: 25 miles = 37.5 pts

30 miles= 45 pts

50 miles= 75 pts.

100 miles= 150 pts.

A roster is to be submitted to the points Sec. by the Team Captain prior to the first ride you wish to count for points. * (The December and January rides will be grandfathered in). Team Captain is responsible for sending ride results to the Team Competition Secretary (within 30 days of the completed ride) You may see the monthly results at www.dbdrteams.blogspot.com

The team rosters are to be renewed/ changed/ added, in January and can only be updated June 1-7, and then only members who have not yet completed a ride in the current ride season may be deleted. You may add a new team member for each inactive member that you delete, but the new members' points prior to June 1 cannot be counted towards the team total; only those points obtained after June 1 may be counted for updated team members.

Team rosters will be published in the (newsletter, website, BlogSpot) rosters to be supplied by the Team Points Secretary. Team points are based upon over all placings. A team must have a minimum of three riders completing the same ride (any distance) of the indicated *(AERC or CTR) ride.

A few extra points are acquired if placing in the top ten. The same chart is used to calculate points as the 300 mile awards. However, Grand Championship and Reserve CH, of a CTR are the only 'extra points' available to CTR rides. No BC extra points on endurance. No ties for placing will be counted. (Example: No ties for 1st place. Would have to be 1st & 2nd.)

If more than three members complete on the same ride, the top three overall placings will count for team points, with the exception of a **Bonus rider**. **If six or more team members complete on the same day, same ride, then both 'teams' will be counted. Any horse/rider combination allowed; membership on a team belongs to the rider.**
