**DISTANCES:** Thursday 55 miles, Friday and Saturday 25/50 miles.

**DIRECTIONS: From the South;** I-65 to exit #41 turn left, towards Uniontown on Hwy 250. Go about 14 miles. Hwy 250 will become Hwy 50 going through Brownstown, go another 3 miles and turn right onto Hwy 135. Go about 5.5 miles and then turn left onto Hwy 58. Go 4.2 miles, you will come to the small community of Kurtz, and you will turn right on N. Cleveland, going by the fire station. Continue about 6 miles to camp, the road will become Pike Rd, and then it turns into Cornett and then finally into County Road 1150. Camp is on left.

**From the North:** I-65 to exit # 64 and then turn right (west) on hwy 58. Go about 16 miles and turn right on W. Columbus Pike, go .4 miles and turn Left onto 135/58 and go 1.4 miles and turn right onto hwy 58. Go 4.2 miles and you will come to the small community of Kurtz., you will turn right on N. Cleveland, going by the fire station. Continue about 6 miles to camp, the road will become Pike Rd, and then it turns into Cornett and then finally into County Road 1150. Camp is on left.

**CAMPING:** Primitive and electric sites available, call for reservations 812-995-8812 or 812-497-2051 or just check in when you arrive.

**FOOD:** There will be a potluck meal on Thursday with meat supplied, please bring a dish to pass, Friday night cookout, and a meal served on Saturday with music performed by **John Crance**. Café 58 (located 6 miles away in Kurtz) serves breakfast, lunch and dinner. Brownstown (about 20 miles from camp) has service stations, grocery stores, etc.

**AWARDS:** Completion, Best Condition, First to finish, Top Ten, Junior, and an award for those completing all 3-days on the same horse.

**Bridle tags are required, yearly and day passes can be purchase at camp.**

**TERRIAN:** The trails in Hoosier National Forest offer a wide variety of terrain and scenery from rolling hills to wide forest trails with some graveled forestry roads. Shoes are recommended. A farrier will be available.
