RELEASE OF LEGAL LIABILITY

As a participant in the Kentucky Diehards endurance ride, I agree to abide by the rules of AERC, OAATS, AHA, and ride management. I understand that endurance riding involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and man-made hazards, which ride management, cannot anticipate, identify, modify or eliminate; that horses (equines) are excitable, difficult to control and unpredictable; that accidents can happen to anyone at any time. I agree to take full responsibility for myself and the equine I am riding/handling. I will hold ride manager Jim Rogan, ride management, all ride personnel and volunteers, all veterinarians and Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill, Harrodsburg, Kentucky, and all property owners over whose land the ride crosses blameless for any accident, injury or loss that might occur due to my participating in the ride, and free from all liability for such injury or loss. Under Kentucky Law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professionals not liable for an injury or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities,

Stalls and paddocks will be reserved upon receipt of ride application.

Camping will be in the West Lot area of Shaker Village. Primitive camping, no electrical hookups. Horse water will be available. All vet checks will be at the camp site in the West Lot. Vetting of horses will begin on Friday at 3 o'clock p.m. until dark. Please make every effort to arrive at Shaker Village before dark on Friday. You must cross a narrow bridge located at a turn in the road, and it is much easier to cross during daylight than at night.

The trails will be primarily through rolling hills in open pasture, and will border historic rock fences. There will be a few creek crossings with plenty of rocks. However, pads are not recommended.

Shaker Village has reserved a number of rooms in the West Lot Lodge and Wash House for the ride. If you want to reserve a room, please call Ann Voris at Shaker Village 1-800-734-5611, extension 1548. For information about Shaker Village see its web site shakervillageky.org.

If you plan to arrive on Thursday, November 17, 2011, please call Don Pelly (1-800-734-5611, extension 128 or 859-325-0408) so he can make camping arrangements for you. Early arrival fee of \$10.00 must be paid to Shaker Village. You can pay this fee upon check in.

CANCELLATION OF RIDE

In the event of extreme temperatures, freezing rain, or a severe snowstorm, you will be notified on Thursday, November 17, 2011, that the ride has been canceled. In the event of cancellation, you will receive a refund of all ride fees except the \$30.00 deposit which is non refundable.

Shaker Village is located at the caution light on U.S. 68, at the intersection of KY Route 33. The entrance to Shaker Village is six miles east of the intersection of U.S. 127, Harrodsburg bypass and U.S. 68. It is not recommended that you take U.S. 68 from Lexington to Shaker Village due to the tight turns going down to the Kentucky River.

After turning into Shaker Village, turn left at the guard house, drive past the pond and keep driving on the blacktop road to the West Lot, about a 1 mile.
